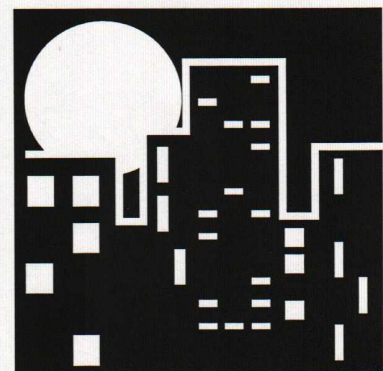

Steps to Finding God:

#1 Realize God's Desire

#2 Recognize Our Problem
