



Highpoint Kids Policies for Relaunching in-Church Gatherings

Important Dates (Subject to change and updates)

July 12th

- 9am and 10:30am service open to public by online reservation
- Childcare only for children ages up to four years old by reservation until room capacity.

July 19th

- Same and 12th PLUS: The Outpost for K-5th Graders!

Volunteers

- All Volunteers must be healthy and free of any symptoms of illness.
- All Volunteers must be background checked and cleared to serve as usual.
- All Volunteers must watch relaunch training video from Pastor Karl before they serve with children.
- Volunteers MUST be checked-in and in their ministry room ready to serve 20 minutes before service.
- Due to low count allowed per room, we will operate on minimal staffing to allow more room for kids. It will be essential that volunteers that commit to serving show up, as we will be staffed with exactly what is needed with no room for “no shows.”
- Volunteers need to cheerfully and positively help us all follow the guidelines. Please refrain from personal opinions, political statements or other negative talk while serving. Our job is to create a safe and positive experience for our guests and those serving with us.

Health Procedures

- All Volunteers in every capacity will enter through main church entrance to have their temperature checked. Look to the right as you enter the first set of door. Any person with a temperature of 100 or over will need to exit. A green sticker to be given to those who have had their temperature checked.
- All Volunteers will be responsible to follow the Cleaning/Cleanliness Procedures. If you are unable or unwilling for any reason, please let us know before you volunteer to serve.
- Volunteers must wear face masks the entire service in order to serve. No exceptions.
- Volunteers must use gloves when handling cleaning supplies or changing diapers.
- Volunteers need to avoid physical contact with children, parents or other volunteers as much as is possible. For now, avoid hugs and handshakes. As much as we miss them, we want to ensure that all of our guests feel comfortable during this transition.
- Rooms will be cleaned with surfaces wiped down before and after each service.
 - Early Childhood – This includes changing tables, toilet, sink, door knobs, rails, toys, etc.
 - The Outpost – restroom and chairs that were used. Anything else what was touched/used.
- Parents will not be permitted to enter classrooms, dropping children off at the door.
